The Eastern half has a mixture of many building types including residential complexes like Cusrow Baug and commercial like Electric House. 3. Museum Sub-Precinct: The main landmark in this precinct is the Prince of Wales Museum. It also has many other institutional buildings in the Kalaghoda Area like the Indian Institute of Sciences and the Secretariat. 4. University Precinct: This is the set of Victoria Gothic building fronting Oval Maidan and include the University and the High Court. To the north are the PWD building and the CTO building. 5. Esplanade Sub-Precinct: Bounded by D N Road and Hazarimal Somani Marg this was a planned exercise after the demolition of the fort walls on the Esplanade. It is characterized by a grid iron pattern with g+3 predominantly commercial buildings. Tit laso has a few institutional buildings like the J B Petit High School, J N Petit Library, etc. 6. Foutnain Precinct: Located between Dr D. N. Road, MG Road and Cawasji Patel Street, this area is chaarcterised by the presence of the Flora Fountain at the junction of Veer Nariman and D N Road. The buildings are extrememyl closely knit with narrow alleys in between g+4 to g+5 high. Predominantly this forms the commercial hub of the fort precinct. 7. Horniman Circle Sub				Troposeu

A common neo-classical façade of g+3 encircles this garden. 8. Naval Dockyard Sub-Precinct: The eastern edge is formed by the waterfront while Shahid Bhagat Singh Road forms the western edge. Historic Structures like the Manor House are found in this precinct. This is one of the most historically important precinct of the city. 9. Ballard Estate Sub-Precinct: This is the planned business district of the fort precinct. It was built during the excavation of the Prince's and Alexandra Docks. 					The densest Sub-Precinct of the Fort precinct was the 'native' town within the walls of the fort. The buildings have narrow plots and congested streets forming thoroughfares. 11. V T Precinct: One of the most imageable sub-precincts it is characterized by the presence of the CST, the GPO and St Georges Hospital. 12. BMC Precinct: Triangular in shape, many institutional bu8idlgins can be found on the main streets along the periphery.
